Rx DESTROYER™ Directions

- 1. Load medications into the bottle Use funnel for easy loading
 - Load patches into bottle
 - Squirt syringe dose into bottle
 - DO NOT place syringe or vial into the bottle, use Sharps container
- 2. Tightly secure cap and gently shake for 10 seconds
- 3. Store in safe area and use again
- 4. After each drug disposal session, repeat step #2
- 5. Bottle is full when contents rises within 2" from top of bottle
- **6.** Discard full bottle in common garbage
 - Do not pour contents in a sink or flush in toilets
 - Funnel can be used again Do not discard

OPTIONAL:

Prior to discarding bottle, Hardener Packet(s) may be added to convert liquid contents to a solid. Help to prevent accidental liquid spills in garbage can. Refer to instructions on Hardener Packet.

Pills, Liquids, Syringe Injectables, Fentanyl Patches, Suppositories, & Lozenges

- Medications begin dissolving on contact
- Activated carbon adsorbs/neutralizes
- Outer Capsule and fentanyl patch will not dissolve
- Meets EPA solid Non-Hazardous waste guidelines (refer to facility, local, state, tribal and federal disposal guidelines)
